4	<p>Although Japanese companies have made great progress in their treatment of female workers, more needs to be done, especially in terms of child raising and salaries.</p> <p>Today, many female employees stop working to raise children. However, if companies implemented flexible schedules or provided assistance with daycare this would not be necessary. This would allow valuable female employees to continue contributing to their firms while raising children.</p> <p>Unequal salaries are also a big problem. Average pay rates are much higher for men than for women, and even highly educated women tend to earn less than their male counterparts. However, women are just as capable as men, so this is unfair.</p> <p>Women make up a large part of Japan's workforce and are crucial to the success of its companies, so it is essential that they are paid more and that it become easier for them to continue working while raising children.</p>
