We live in an increasingly complex and dangerous world, facing threats such as global warming, drought, and religious extremism. There is no better time for Japan to stand up and make a greater impact on world affairs.

This needs to be reconsidered as the world is a very different place than it was 65 years ago. As the saying goes, actions speak louder than words, and future generations will rightly be angry if Japan does not act now to make the world a safer place.
