

## *Hungry Hikers*

People are having a bigger and bigger effect on wild animals. As a result, new laws and special parks are being created to protect nature. Some changes have been very successful. For example, there were about 170 wild elephants in 1980 in Yunnan, China. These days, experts think that there are around 300 elephants there. However, the elephants have ( **28** ). As cities get bigger and more farms are needed to feed people, there are not as many places for animals like elephants.

Big animals can cause big problems for people. Because there is not enough food in protected areas, elephants often leave these areas to take food from farms. In fact, a group of about 14 elephants from Yunnan went on a 500-kilometer walk to look for food during 2020 and 2021. The elephants sometimes went through towns trying to find food. They appeared on the TV news and the Internet. As a result, they ( **29** ) China. People were interested to find out what would happen to them next.

Finally, the elephants returned to a protected area in Yunnan. However, to try to prevent similar adventures in the future, experts have designed a special “food court” for elephants. The food court cost \$15 million to build and is about 670,000 square meters. It has five ponds where elephants can drink, and all the plants that elephants need to eat to stay healthy. The experts hope that it will be enough to ( **30** ).

## *Spicy Soda*

Ginger ale is a spicy soft drink. It was invented in Ireland in the 1850s. However, the type that is most popular today was created by a man called John McLaughlin who lived in Toronto, Canada. After he graduated from college in Canada, he went to study in New York City. While studying, he worked part-time at a drugstore. He noticed that many people were buying soda water from the store and mixing it with different fruit flavors.

McLaughlin returned to Toronto in 1890 and started a soda water company. It became very successful. One reason was that his advertisements said the water provided by the city was dangerous and caused diseases. He recommended that people drink his fruit-flavored soda water instead. He also made machines called soda fountains. People could use them to buy McLaughlin's drinks. The machines became popular with shoppers in busy department stores, especially on hot summer days.

McLaughlin had poor health, and he had to stop being the manager of his company. However, he continued inventing new drinks. He knew about ginger ale from Ireland, but many of his customers did not like its sweet flavor. McLaughlin spent three years trying to create the perfect kind of ginger ale. Finally, by 1904, he had created a lighter, spicier drink. McLaughlin's wife liked it so much that she said it was "the champagne of ginger ales."

McLaughlin's "Canada Dry Pale Ginger Ale" was a success. As well as being delicious on its own, it could also be mixed with other drinks. Some people like to drink it rather than beer or other alcoholic drinks. Moreover, the ginger can help people with stomachaches or sore throats. It has been over 100 years since Canada Dry Pale Ginger Ale was invented. In that time, its popularity has spread from Canada, through the United States, and around the world.
