People arriving in a new country often face difficulties integrating into society, which can lead to them experiencing unfair treatment. Language support and outreach programs, however, help such people better assimilate and avoid discrimination.

In these ways, social welfare programs indisputably reduce inequality in society. From closing the wealth gap to improving access to medical care and providing crucial support for foreign residents, they are invaluable for creating a more egalitarian society.
