- Date A: Candidates registered through group applications at elementary, middle, and high schools, combined schools (elementary-middle, middle-high, elementary-middle-high), technical colleges, advanced courses of specialized training colleges, special needs schools, education boards, universities, and junior colleges.
- Date B: Candidates registered through group applications at cram schools.
- The following cases will take the exam on Date A (Grades 1 to 3):
  - · Candidates at certain special venues, such as overseas or remote islands.
  - · Examinees requiring special accommodations due to disabilities, etc.

Note: Second-stage test dates will be continuously updated on the Eiken website for each test session.

### Grades 1, Pre-1, 2, Pre-2, and 3

- Examinees born on or after April 2, 2003 (under 20 years old) will be scheduled for Date B.
- Examinees born on or before April 1, 2003 (21 years old and over) will be scheduled for Date A.

#### Grade 1:

The second stage test for both Date A and Date B will be held in 14 locations nationwide (Sapporo, Sendai, Yokohama, Chiyoda, Shinjuku/Toshima, Setagaya, Niigata, Nagoya, Kyoto, Umeda, Tennoji, Hiroshima, Fukuoka, Southern Okinawa Island).

### Grades 1, Pre-1, 2, Pre-2, and 3:

The second stage exam for both Date A and Date B will be conducted nationwide.

## Special Cases for Date A (Grades 1 to 3)

- · Examinees at special venues such as overseas or remote islands.
- · Examinees requiring accommodations due to disabilities.
